High Quality Support, Care and Guidance

Students at St Mary's feel safe, happy, respected and valued.

All staff and students are proactive in promoting positive behaviour for learning in the classroom and within the school and local community. Outstanding pastoral care, matched carefully to the individual needs of each student, ensures the very highest standards of conduct, safety and wellbeing.

Each year group is part of a Teaching & Learning Area Team that includes an identified form tutor for each student. Students meet with their tutors on a daily basis who will check that they are prepared for learning and provide additional support as it is required. Tutors know their students well, monitor their progress and provide a point of contact for parents/carers.

All students are stretched and challenged in their learning through a wide range of teaching and enrichment activities and strong links with universities, employers and industry. Specialist provision is organised for those students who have identified learning needs or who require emotional or behavioural support.

Citizenship and personal endeavour are highly valued. All students are accountable for their own actions and enjoy opportunities to hold positions of responsibility, encourage others and make a positive contribution to school life.

Enrichment Opportunities

An extensive enrichment programme supports and extends student learning. All students are actively encouraged to broaden their experience through involvement with: • Extracurricular activities

Our Sixth Form & Leadership Centre offers an inspirational and distinctive Post 16 learning experience that builds on prior learning and provides learning pathways to support progression to university, training or employment. St Mary's provides courses that meet the needs of all students who wish to access high quality Post 16 learning. There is also an extensive programme of academic support for preparation of UCAS and Oxbridge applications, curriculum vitae and interviews. The Post 16 Tutor Team and Academic Mentor meet with students regularly to discuss academic progress, career aspirations and progression pathways.

Unique features of our Sixth Form & Leadership Centre include Professional Learning Placements for students studying on level 2 or level 3 courses that provide the opportunity to work in business/industry alongside studies in school.
