Re: Overseas Trips

Next academic year, 2022-23, sees the return of overseas trips following an enforced 2 year break. We have made a decision to run 3 main overseas trips, the details of which are outlined in the table below. We are publishing these to parents now, so you can plan ahead should you wish your child to attend. Further details will be published by letter, approximately one year in advance of the trip.

The Ski trip letter was published recently and we are pleased to advise that the deadline to pay the initial deposit for the trip **has now been extended to Thursday 31st March.**

Communication re City of Paris will be sent out at the end of March with the initial deposit due towards the end of April. Communication re Rome will be sent out at the end of May with the initial deposit due at the end of June.

We have made the difficult decision that students in year 11 and 13 will not be able to attend these trips during that year. This is mainly due to the impact on their studies which we have experienced in the past, in particular coursework completion, attendance at interventions and revision for PPE's.

These overseas trips will be supplemented by the return of UK based trips, in particular, whole year group trips at the end of the summer term available to all students and curriculum based trips run by individual subject areas. We will be publishing further details in due course.
