What is an Apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a paid job where the employee learns and gains valuable experiences.

Alongside on-the-job training, apprentices spend at least 20% of their working hours completing classroom-based learning with a college, university or training provider which leads to a nationally recognised qualification.

An apprenticeship includes:

- paid employment with holiday leave
- hands-on-experience in a sector/role of interest
- at least 20% off-the-job training
- formal assessment which leads to a nationally recognised qualification

One of the following qualification levels will be achieved depending on the apprenticeship level:

- Intermediate – level 2 - equivalent to GCSEs
- Advanced – level 3 - equivalent to A Levels
- Higher – level 4,5,6 - equivalent to a foundation degree and above
- Degree – 6, 7 - equivalent to a bachelors or master's degree





Space Engineering

If you're exploring a career in aerospace engineering, this course will give you an insight into modern aircraft design and help your ambitions take flight. Grab this opportunity to speak to Virgin Atlantic engineers, use the Lear Jet Lab at Kingston University, and learn the basics of aircraft flight.

This year they're offering both a residential and a non-residential option, meaning students can either stay at the university throughout the three-day course, or head home at the end of each day. The non-residential course for 14 to 15-year-olds covers the basics of flight, whilst the residential course for 15 to 16-year-olds provides added exposure to university life so students can consider their options in more depth

Micro Computing (Yr. 12 Residential)

Computer engineers combine computer science with electronic engineering to design computer systems and develop hardware and software. This course at Birmingham City University will boost your knowledge of electronics and engineering, as you work in teams to design and build a functional micro-mouse robot.

With the help of their partners, and the funding from their founder Dr. Cosby Smallpeice, all their courses are subsidised or free of charge. The role will also involve working at four different councils, including Epping, Harlow, St Albans as well as Broxbourne.

As an Internal Audit Apprentice, you will support the team in the delivery of audits across the four councils, in line with the Annual Audit Plan and also any ad-hoc tasks required by the Head of Internal Audit including investigations and supporting project groups. Working with fellow auditors you will undertake a range of financial and non-financial audits, assessing the effectiveness of controls and risk management systems in place and identifying opportunities for improvement in those processes.

For the trainee auditor role, the successful applicant will undertake on the job training for four days per week and college/study activities leading to an AAT Apprentice qualification one day per week during term time. This role may lead to a future permanent post and the opportunity to study for a professional Internal Audit qualification. Applicants should be educated to 'A' level standard, ideally with two good 'A' levels and must have GCSE passes in Maths and English.

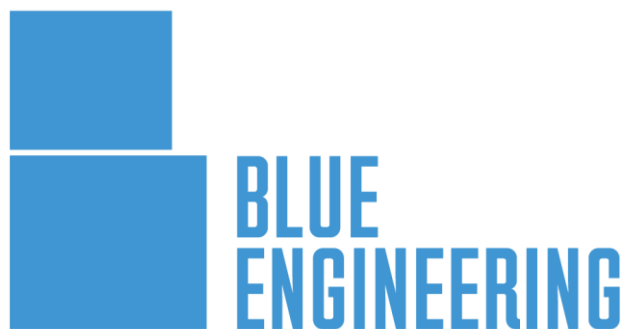
Level 4 Acoustics Technician Apprenticeship

An exciting career opportunity for a committed and reliable candidate to join a specialised team in their Cheshunt office as an Acoustics Technician Apprentice.

They specialise in Environmental Acoustics which includes noise impact assessments for planning applications for new residential developments (BS8233:2014), noise impact assessments for mechanical plant (BS4142:2014), control of entertainment noise from licensed premises and live outdoor events and they also provide licensing support to the hospitality industry. This is a Level 4 apprenticeship which lasts 24 months and upon successful completion should lead to recognition with the Engineering Council (EngTech). What will the apprentice be doing?

At this early stage of a career, the responsibilities start basic and build over time. Your responsibilities will first grow to be:

- Create and update records, keep the digital filing in order
- Maintain the office
- Manage purchases for the office
- Raise and chase client invoices
- Manage phone calls and post
- Manage and set up meetings
- Organise the staff socials
- Take minutes for key meetings
- Keep tabs on changes that would improve our environment

What training will the apprentice take and what qualification will the apprentice get at the end?

Once settled into the business, they would select an appropriate Degree Level Apprenticeship for you to enrol on. They believe the Business Management Degree at London South Bank University (LSBU) is a good choice for building a career in business. These apprenticeships typically take 4 years, and you receive a BA (Hons) degree on successful completion.

You do not need to pay for any training costs and therefore this is an excellent way to get a degree for free. During term time, your working week would change to four days in the office and one day at college. Upon successful completion, you will gain Chartered manager (degree) apprenticeship standard.

For this apprenticeship they look for individuals who have an interest in mechanics, a general understanding of IT, and preferably 4 GCSE grade 4 or above including English and Maths.

If there are any who don't meet the criteria for qualifications they may still be considered for the course, as an entry assessment is completed and additional modules can be provided for English and Maths.

As an Apprentice you will be enrolled in a blended learning programme where you will gain an NVQ Level 3 in Plant Maintenance through a mixture of on the job experience and block release training through a leading college.

Their Apprenticeship Programme covers all the essential skills and principles you will need to become a Plant Mechanic and you'll learn how to service and repair machines and equipment, including replacing parts and checking and calibrating instruments. You'll also study everything from basic engineering skills to the latest technological advancements in electro-hydraulics and computerised control systems.

Their Apprenticeship Programme allows you to earn as you learn:

- Apprentices under 18 joining their programme you will be required to work a maximum of 39 hours per week with a starting salary of £12,400 per annum.
- Apprentices over 18 joining our programme you will be required to work a maximum of 42.5 hours per week with a starting salary of £13,500 per annum.

After successful completion of Year 1 you will automatically be placed on the National Minimum Wage rate for your age group and as you progress through each year of your apprenticeship your salary will continue to increase.
