Careers in Film, TV, VFX, Animation & Games

Play Your Way Into Production is an incredible game, created by the Screen Industries Growth Network at the University of York with One to One Development Trust where you get to explore an immersive and interactive film set as a new junior member of the team

Play Your Way Into Production has been produced as part of a research project to break down barriers to getting into the screen industry. The game is designed help potential new entrants understand the tasks and duties of certain job roles and develop skills which are traditionally gained through (unpaid) work experience. The game is particularly relevant to those studying film/media courses

Set in a film/TV studio, the fictitious Pink Sprout Productions company are making a CGI dinosaur documentary. Players are plunged into unfamiliar the world of film/TV studio, and are given a number of tasks to complete and scenarios to navigate that reflect some of those that may be encountered when working in the industry, which will challenge their perceptions.

The game features a TV/film studio environment populated by 17 crew members with varied backgrounds and experience. As well as playing the game, players can explore technical equipment and props, overhearing conversations, taking on tasks and helping out with the shoot.

Sutton Trust US Programme

Supporting bright state school students from across the UK to apply to and secure funding at top US universities. The Sutton Trust US Programme is designed to support high-achieving state school students from across the UK to explore US study and access leading universities. It includes two residentials in the UK, before all students spend a week in the US staying on campus at a leading US university and visiting a variety of other American universities. An optional second year of the programme supports students to apply to US universities alongside their UCAS options.

Since the programme started, more than 400 participants have been offered places and funding at top US universities. The Programme is founded and funded by the Sutton Trust, the UK's leading social mobility charity, and delivered in partnership with the Fulbright Commission, who are experts in helping UK students study in the US. It is free to take part in the programme.

Sixth Form Supracurricular Exploration Guidance University of Cambridge

Supracurricular exploration is an important way to expand your knowledge of your subject, explore your interests and develop your skills. Supracurricular activities are subject-specific academic exploration that builds on and goes beyond what you are studying in school or college. Supracurricular activities are usually different to extracurricular activities because they are academic in focus and directly relevant to the subject you want to study at university. Supracurricular activities, therefore, refer to anything you do to explore your subject in greater depth in your own time.

Reading can be an excellent way of exploring topics that interest you and much supracurricular study will usually take that form. Bear in mind, however, that there are many other ways to deepen your understanding. You could visit your local museums, listen to podcasts, watch documentaries, attend seminars or taster days offered by universities, or enter competitions. For STEM subjects in particular it is also important to find ways to practice key subject-specific skills. For example, you might like to work through problems to challenge your problem-solving skills, and consolidate your knowledge of key concepts.

Lucy Cavendish's dedicated webpage contains guidance on supracurricular exploration and a comprehensive source of resources, grouped according to undergraduate degrees at Cambridge. This includes podcasts, videos, websites, journals and more.




Super-Curricular Resources for Students University of Oxford
