insight4me Sociology: Contemporary Families With Dr Emma Huddleston From UEA & Professor Paul Hodgkinson From University of Surrey

Contemporary Fathers – Experiences, Expectations & Wellbeing. What involvement do contemporary fathers have in caring and parenting? How does becoming a father affect men's life, identity and wellbeing? What kind of social expectations do fathers encounter, and what kind of challenges do these create? In this talk we examine the role and experience of fathers and the way in which they are positioned by society.

Qualitative research exploring **Military Families** and their experiences of war and military life – focusing on methods used and key findings from the research. Specifically, she will explore how interviews with civilian partners of service personnel enabled her to identify the various ways in which the UK Armed Forces relies upon partners' gendered labour and support to achieve its aims.

Lucy Cavendish College, Cambridge's Academic Attainment Programme is now open for and the deadline to apply is 12pm on Tuesday 7th October.

As the most diverse College in Cambridge, admitting over 90% of their UK students from state schools, they are dedicated to supporting high-achieving students to reach their full potential.

The Academic Attainment Programme is a programme for around 1000 high-achieving UK state-school students in Year 12 who meet certain Widening Participation criteria. You can find the full list of criteria [here](#).

The focus of this programme is on raising attainment, by supporting students in their A-Level studies, so that they can reach their potential and achieve the highest possible grades, and in making applications to competitive universities.

Lucy Cavendish College are particularly excited that for the second year in a row they have expanded the programme to allow even more participants and so it will not only cover Year 12 but also Year 13, meaning students can continue to be supported as they complete university applications and summer examinations.

As part of the programme:

- Students will get access to subject-specific enrichment classes led by experts, to allow them to develop and expand on their knowledge of the content of their A-Levels and to help them to achieve the very best grades in their examinations.
- They will also attend Peer Discussion Groups, to prepare them for the university environment by improving their oracy and their problem-solving skills.
