The Conference is co-run by a Committee of seven undergraduate Law students and the Faculty of Law. Both free and self-funded places are available depending on widening participation criteria.

Deadline: 11:45pm, 31st December

Open to: students in Year 12

Applicants qualifying for free places must meet at least one of our widening participation criteria, which include but are not limited to:

- Attending a maintained school
- Care experienced
- Having been eligible for Free School Meals at any point during the last six years
- Live in area of low progression to higher education (POLAR4 - quintiles 1 & 2)
- Live in area of high deprivation (IMD - quintiles 1 & 2)
- Attend a low-performing Sixth Form
- Attend/attended a low-performing GCSE school
- Are from an ethnic or religious minority background (ERM)
- Are from any background or region of the UK which is under-represented at the University of Cambridge

You will combine university learning with officer training and earn while you learn.

Entry requirements

You must have – or be working towards one – 2 A-Levels or a Level 3 qualification. Training or work experience equivalent to a Level 3 qualification is also acceptable. You also must have a Level 2 in English at either a GCSE Grade C or above or Grades 4 to 9.

How long does it take?

3 years

What happens when you finish?

You will be a fully qualified Police Constable with a BSc in Policing Practice. The starting salary is £42,210. On successful completion of training, you'll earn £47,475. All salaries include allowances.

Solicitor Apprenticeship Programme - London – 2026

Overview
